
CARGO AGENTS GRANTED ACCESS TO VESSELS: STRICT SECURITY PROTOCOLS WITHIN THE SOUTH AFRICAN PORT SYSTEM DURING THE LOCKDOWN PERIOD

Kindly note that in the second phase of the lockdown, TNPA has revised the security protocols within the South African Port System, to allow Cargo Agents to board the vessels. All other measures proclaimed in the first stakeholder circular will remain in force until further notice.

The Cargo Agents allowed to board vessels are expected to adhere to the COVID-19 Regulations by ensuring the use of the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and other safety precautions deemed necessary by TNPA, and must present themselves for daily screening at the designated TNPA facilities, before entering the ports and/or boarding vessels.

TNPA Security Management would like to thank all our stakeholders for their contribution in combating the pandemic by adhering to the security protocols.
