

## T1.1 Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

TRANSNET SOC Ltd trading through its Operating Division Transnet National Ports Authority (hereinafter referred to as TNPA) (the *Employer*) invites tenders for:

### **the Rehabilitation of the Transverse Steel Structure at Syncrolift in the Port of Cape Town**

It is estimated that tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of **2ME** or **2SL** or higher;

Only tenderer's who satisfy the following **Substantive Responsiveness/ eligibility** criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

#### **PART I**

- i. Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, for a **2ME** class of mechanical engineering works or **2SL** class of specialist works , are eligible to have their tenders evaluated;
- ii. Compulsory Briefing Session Attendance; and

- iii. **Quality** - Minimum Threshold 60%

Preference will be given to local respondents based on their BBBEE status and quality.
