NOTICE OF AND INVITATION TO SUBMIT COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT GUIDELINES FOR AGREEMENTS, LICENSES AND PERMITS IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL PORTS ACT 12 OF 2005, AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION EXTENDED TO 30 APRIL 2024

Transnet NATIONAL Ports Authority (“the Authority”) **hereby extends** the timeline for public comments on the draft “Guidelines for Agreements, Licences and Permits in terms of the National Ports Act 12 of 2005” (“Guidelines”) and supporting documentation **to no later than 17h00 on 30 April 2024**.

Upon receipt of comments, and having duly considered and factored them, the revised Guidelines will be finalized, and issued in terms of the National Ports Act 12 of 2005.
